- Program Itinerary -

Friday 18 March

Fly overnight to Munich

Saturday 19 March

11:00 AM (estimated) Arrive and check into Ibis Munich Nord. Take a short breather.

12:00 PM Classroom session in hotel conference room to set context for the sites to be seen and

activities to be experienced while on tour in Munich.

1:00 PM Depart hotel to catch subway to Marienplatz for walking tour. Once there, group will

explore, get lunch at the outdoor market, and just generally acclimate to the new time

zone. Students have free time to explore the central square.

6:00 PM Group dinner at Hofbrauhaus (included in program fee).

8:00 PM Return to Ibis Munich Nord Hotel.

Sunday 20 March

8:00 AM Breakfast and classroom session at hotel: The Creation and Maintenance of the Nazi

Police State.

9:15 AM Depart Ibis Munich Nord to catch the U6 to Central Station. From there, catch the S2

train to Dachau.

10:00 AM Tour Dachau Memorial Site (concentration camp).

3:30 PM Depart Dachau.

4:30 PM Arrive Marienplatz. Students enjoy some free time. Reconvene at 6:00 pm for dinner at

Weisses Bräuhaus München. (This dinner included in program fee).

8:30 PM Dismissal.

Monday 21 March

9:00 AM Classroom session to discuss (1) the role of criminological theory in justifying the

Eugenics and Racial Hygiene Programs during the Third Reich, (2) places in Munich that

were important to the Third Reich, and (3) German guilt and Holocaust "Fatigue."

10:00 AM Depart hotel for Third Reich Walking Tour.

10:30 AM Join guide and begin walking tour in Marienplatz.

1:00 PM Park Cafe for lunch.

2:30 PM Free afternoon. Note: Dr. Kane will recommend optional visits to the Deutches Museum

and/or Allianz Arena for students interested in visiting one or both of these locations in Munich (easily accessible via subway). For students who visit the Deutches Museum,

your entrance fee will be paid by the program.

5:30 PM Regroup on Marienplatz to take a headcount and discuss dinner. Students are then free

to get dinner on their own.

8:00 PM Arrive back at Hotel Ibis to watch movie, *Judgment at Nuremberg*.

10:00 PM Dismissal.

Tuesday 22 March

8:00 AM Depart Ibis Munich Nord for Nuremberg. After taking the U6 to Central Station, group will

catch the 8:51am ICE 724 non-stop train to Nuremberg.

9:51 AM Arrive Nuremberg. Group will walk to the hotel and drop luggage, then head to Nazi

Rally Grounds and Documentation Center.

11:00 AM Arrive Nazi Rally Grounds and Documentation Center – Nuremberg.

11:15 AM Guided Tour of Rally Grounds.

1:15 PM Lunch on your own inside the museum (or next door at the outdoor restaurant area), and

then explore museum on your own.

4:15 PM Depart Documentation Center for Hotel Ibis (group has some flexibility with timeline).

5:00 PM (estimated) Depart hotel for dinner. (This dinner is included in program fee.)

9:00 PM Return to hotel for night.

Wednesday 23 March

9:00 AM Depart Hotel Ibis Munich Nord for visit to The Memorium Nuremberg Trials (Courtroom

600).

2:00 PM Return to hotel to catch charter bus to Prague. Note: during bus ride Dr. Kane will give

some background on our visit to Czech, and in particular on the Terezin Ghetto and

Concentration Camp.

6:00 PM (estimated). Arrive Prague. Check into Ibis Praha Old Town. Head into Old Town and

get dinner from any vendor on the square.

Thursday 24 March

8:00 AM Depart hotel for daytrip to Terezin Ghetto and Concentration Camp. The camp is 45

minutes north of Prague (by bus). This excursion includes transportation, guided tour of

the memorial, and lunch in the Medieval town of Litoměřice.

4:00 PM Arrive back in Prague. Enjoy a free afternoon and dinner on your own.

Friday 25 March

9:00 AM Breakfast and Classroom session to discuss Nazi invasion and occupation of Prague.

2:45 PM Catch the 5 tram to the 22 tram to visit the KGB Museum, and the Museum of Military

Resistance.

5:00 PM Back to Náměstí Republiky. Dinner on your own.

Saturday 26 March

9:00 AM Depart hotel for tour of Prague Castle. We will take a tram (street car) to the castle.

1:00 PM Group lunch (included in program fee), and then enjoy a free afternoon in Prague.

5:45 PM Regroup in Staroměstské náměstí (Old Town Prague's main central square).

6:00 PM Dinner together at the Terrace Restaurant atop the Hotel U Prince on Staroměstské

náměstí (included in program fee).

Sunday 27 March

Depart Prague (most of us).
