The Drexel in London program is open to all majors. Certain majors do have a specific term that has been pre-selected by their department as the best term to participate (see below). If your major is NOT listed below, we encourage you to meet with your academic advisor to discuss the best course options and most suitable term for you.

- **Graphic Design** – summer term sophomore year
- **Interior Design** – summer term junior year
- **Design & Merchandising** – summer term junior year
- **Nursing & Health Professions** – spring term sophomore, pre-junior, junior year
- **Music Industry Business** – spring term junior year
